

Ways to Give

Cash Gifts - Cash gifts can be made through credit and debit card transactions, outright cash, personal checks, cashier's checks or money orders.

Gift Pledges - HACC welcomes gifts through multiyear pledges, which serve as a formal statement of intention to make a gift to the College. With a pledge, you may complete your gift by making regular contributions over the time period specified as part of your pledge.

Gifts of Appreciated Securities, Stocks and Bonds -

These gifts provide considerable tax advantages when transferred to HACC before they are sold. If you have held your securities for more than one year, your gift may provide a two-fold tax benefit, creating an income tax deduction.

Matching Gifts – An easy way to double or even triple your donation to HACC is to find out if your company has a matching gift program. These programs typically match all or a percentage of employee contributions to charitable organizations, making the employer a partner in your personal philanthropy.

Retirement Savings - Supporters of the College can designate the HACC Foundation as a beneficiary of a portion of their retirement funds. If you decide to make such a generous gift, please be sure to list the HACC Foundation with the administrator or person in charge of your individual retirement account (IRA), profit-sharing account or other retirement plan.
