1. I just wanted to inquire about the CARES Act. Is there an application available?

The College received CARES Act monies last academic year and distributed all of the funds as emergency financial aid grants directly to eligible students.

The College has been awarded additional federal stimulus funds through the

Coronavirus Response and Relief Supplemental Appropriations Act (CRRSAA) and the American Rescue Plan (ARP). The College recently received guidance from the U.S. Department of Education regarding eligibility of students and is in the process of developing a distribution plan.

From 12:01 a.m. on June 30 through 11:59 p.m. on July 1, 2021, HACC students will not be able to:

- Access HACCWeb
- Register for credit and noncredit summer or fall 2021 classes
- Drop classes (please note that the <u>drop period</u> for the first eight-week summer semester is extended to July 5, 2021.)
- View and browse classes
- View their student account in Banner
- Request academic transcripts and certificates of residency
- Access financial aid
- View "pay my account" and "enroll in HACC payment plan"
- Access course merchant to register for noncredit classes
